
On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Karnataka has decided to issue an No Objection Certificate to start **New Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital** at by Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore with an Intake capacity **100 seats** in BAMS Degree Course for the year 2018-19.

It is certified that:-

- a) The Inspection consisting of **Dr. Shyla R.J.B. Yoganand & Dr. R. Shylajakumari**, Professors, Government Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Bangalore has visited **Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore** on 25-04-2017 and submitted report on **26-04-2017** the Inspection team has recommended for Starting of New Ayurvedic Medical College. Hence, the permission may be granted to start the New Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital with the name of **Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore**. The College is attached with **100** bedded Ayurvedic Hospital called **Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore** which has been established in the year **2015**.
- b) It is desirable to establish an Ayurveda College in the public interest and starting a new BAMS Degree course with an Intake Capacity of **100 seats**.
- c) Establishment of Ayurveda College and starting BAMS Degree Course at **Mangaluru** by **Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore** is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate infrastructure and material as per norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine are available with proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurveda College as per Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Council / Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
